	Research Plan	Type in A4 size sheet. Approximately 1,000 words in English, or 2,000 characters in Japanese.

	Transcript of Academic Record	The transcript has to be an official one issued by the president or dean of the department (school) of the applicant. It had to be issued within three months prior to the application date.
	Documents verifying your residential status	<p>If you currently reside in Japan, please submit a photocopy of both sides of your Residence Card (「在留カード」).</p> <p>If you currently reside in countries other than Japan, please submit a photocopy of your passport (data page, face/photo page) instead.</p>
