<p>○授業の到達目標及びテーマ</p> <p>This course aims to explore the East Asian economies using the theoretical framework of international economics: a particular focus will be placed on industrial policy, which include trade and investment policy as a core element. Similarly, economic integration in East Asia (which include both Northeast and Southeast Asian countries) will be examined from the viewpoint of industrial development and economic growth. Students are expected to learn how international economic theories can be applied to explain the industrial development in East Asia, where rapid economic growth has been achieved by adopting outward-looking trade policy and enhancing regional cooperation and integration.</p>			
<p>○授業の概要</p> <p>The course presents and discusses the development of the East Asian economies. First, theories of industrial policy, as well as industrial policies adopted in the East Asian economies after World War II, are reviewed as a matter of background. The relationship between industrial policy and institutions are also discussed because institutional capabilities are a critical factor that have affected the effectiveness of industrial policy in East Asia.</p> <p>Second economic integration in East Asia is discussed with reference to theories of trade, labor migration, and capital movement as well as spatial economics. Finally, the current development strategy that focuses on participation and upgrading in global value chains (GVCs) is discussed in reference to trade theories and East Asian experiences.</p>			
<p>○授業の方法</p> <p>Lectures will be given in English, and in an interactive manner. Students are expected to prepare for each class by reading assigned items and be ready to actively participate. The course assumes students' mastery of or familiarity with an intermediate level of microeconomics.</p>
